English for Speakers of Other Languages

The Hagley English Language Centre offers three strands of courses:

- High School Preparation
- Learning for Living (Everyday English)
- Academic English

High School Preparation

11EJB Junior Beginners

11EJE Junior Elementary

11EJP Junior Pre-Intermediate

All are 24 hours per week and designed for junior students. Each week, students learn integrated English language skills, listening, speaking, reading, grammar and writing for 10-12 hours, Mathematics (4 hours), Science (2-4 hours) and Physical Education (2 hours). 11EJB and 11EJE also have Art and Music (2 hours each), while 11EJP could be offered a choice from subjects such as Textiles, Art, Music and others for 2 hours each.

Qualifications: 11EJB and 11EJE: Basic English Proficiency Certificate. 11EJP: Credits are available in ESOL, Science and Mathematics.

Materials Fee for All Classes: Nil for permanent residents of New Zealand.

11ENW

English for the Workplace

This course is suitable for students who are working towards achieving the eight literacy credits necessary to enter Polytechnic, a trade qualification, or as preparation for 11EAP. The course aims to provide students with a wide range of language skills necessary for study and the workplace.

Students will also study Science, Maths and other subjects.

Qualifications: NCEA Level 1 English credits and Level 2 ESOL credits. Credits are also available in Science and Mathematics.

Materials Fee: \$20 for permanent residents of New Zealand.

Learning for Living - Everyday English

Full Time Study for Seniors

11EFB

Full-Time Beginner English

This course is for students who have little or no English at all. The course consists of 16 hours of English - beginning reading, writing, speaking and listening skills. Students may also take 4 hours of another subject such as NZ Foods, NZ Gardening, NZ Studies.

Qualifications: Working towards Basic English Proficiency Certificate.

Materials Fee: \$20 for permanent residents of New Zealand.

11EFE

Full-Time Elementary English

This course consists of 16 hours of English where speaking, reading, listening, writing and grammar are taught. Students may also take 4 hours of another subject such as NZ Foods, NZ Gardening, NZ Studies.

Qualifications: Basic English Proficiency Certificate.

Materials Fee: \$20



11EFP Full-Time Pre-Intermediate English

This course is designed for senior students. It aims to prepare them for life in New Zealand with an emphasis on everyday English. Listening, reading, writing and speaking are taught. Students may also take 4 hours of another subject such as NZ Foods, NZ Gardening, NZ Studies, Computing for Beginners, Industrial Sewing, and Second Chance Maths as the timetable permits.

Qualifications: Preparation for internal credits in ESOL.

Materials Fee: \$20 for permanent residents of New Zealand.

12EFI Full-Time Intermediate English

This course is designed for senior students who have been designated above pre-intermediate level by testing. This course prepares students for life in New Zealand with an emphasis on everyday English. Listening, reading, writing and speaking are taught. Students will have the opportunity to study Employment Skills and develop a career plan. Students may also take 4 hours of another subject such as NZ Foods, NZ Gardening, NZ Studies, Computing for Beginners, Industrial Sewing and Second Chance Maths as the timetable permits.

Qualifications: Internal credits in ESOL or Employment Skills are on offer.

Materials Fee: \$20 for permanent residents of New Zealand.

12EFU Full-Time Upper Intermediate

This course is designed for senior students who have an upper intermediate to advanced level of English.

Students on this course will study to gain social competence as well as communication skills that are useful for the workplace to further their education. Emphasis is given to developing a wide range of language skills that are necessary in real life situations. In addition, students may take 4 hours of another subject such as NZ Foods, NZ Gardening, NZ Studies, Computing for Beginners, Industrial Sewing and Second Chance Maths as the timetable permits.

Qualifications: Internal credits in ESOL or Employment Skills.

Materials Fee: \$20 for permanent residents of New Zealand.

Learning for Living Everyday English Part-Time Study for Seniors

11EPE Part-Time Elementary English

This course is for elementary learners of English. It consists of 4 hours of integrated language skills - listening, reading, speaking and writing. The emphasis is on English for communication.

Qualifications: Basic English Proficiency Certificate.

Materials Fee: \$20

12EPI Part-Time Intermediate English

This course is for intermediate learners of English. It consists of 4 hours of integrated language skills - listening, reading, speaking and writing. The emphasis is on learning English for communication.

Qualifications: Level 2 and 3 ESOL credits.

Materials Fee: \$20

13EPU Part-Time Upper Intermediate English

This class is for senior students only and provides 4 hours of upper intermediate English tuition. The course content consists of integrated language skills: listening, speaking, reading, writing and employment skills. Students may want to study other mainstream subjects available at Hagley.

Qualifications: NCEA Level 1 English credits, Level 3 ESOL credits and internal credits.

Materials Fee: \$20

Academic English

English for Academic Purposes

These courses are open to both senior and junior students who wish to gain the required NCEA literacy credits needed for University Entrance. Students in these courses can also choose from the full range of academic courses available to all Hagley College students.

11EAP

This course enables students to gain the required literacy credits at NCEA Level 1. The course covers reading, speaking, listening, writing and research.

Qualifications: Up to 28 internal. 2 external credits can be gained in NCEA Level 1 English standards and ESOL Levels 2 and 3 Unit Standards.

Course Duration: 8 hours tuition per week.

Entry Requirements: Students will be tested for placement.

Materials Fee: Nil for permanent residents of New Zealand.

12EAP

This course enables students to gain the required 8 literacy credits at NCEA Level 2 for University Entrance. The course covers reading, speaking, listening, writing, academic vocabulary and research.

Qualifications: NCEA Level 2 Unit Standards and Achievement Standards. Up to 17 internal credits can be gained.

Course Duration: 8 hours tuition per week.

Entry Requirements: An upper intermediate level of English is required. New students will be tested for placement.

Materials Fee: Nil for permanent residents of New Zealand.
