

Junior College Cellphone Use Contract

Hagley Junior College recognises the desire for many students to bring cellphones to school.

As a learning institution we are also mindful of the potential disruption to learning which inappropriate cellphone use can create.

In light of these factors, we wish to remind all students and caregivers that cellphone use at school is a privilege which carries with it particular responsibilities.

If I choose to bring my cellphone to school, I accept that:

- The security of my cellphone is my responsibility.
- My cellphone will be switched off and kept securely in my bag during all lessons, assemblies, fast-tracks and detentions, unless my teacher asks me to use my cellphone as part of a lesson.
- I will not use my cellphone or allow others to use it for the purpose of harassing or intimidating other students.
- I will follow the instructions of any teacher about the use of cellphones in class.
- If I break this contract my cellphone may be taken from me by a teacher and handed to the Assistant Principal, who will decide if I am allowed to continue bringing it to school.
