



Leaving Destination

- Make sure that you Look in the Menu
- If you Click on **Learning Areas**. This will list all the departments we have and within those you can find all the subjects that are offered.
- **My Selected Courses** is where you will be creating the list of subjects that you would like to do
- **Favourite Courses** are ones you have tagged as you have looked through and might want to consider and can come back to later
- **Useful Information** – has information on selecting courses and NCEA



Points to remember

- Full Year subjects count as 2 on the course count
- Half Year (semesterised) subjects count as 1 on the course count
- In Year 11 – You need to be taking 6 subjects (course count of 12) must include English/Te Reo, Maths and Science
- In Year 12 – You need to be taking 5.5 subjects (course count of 11)
- In Year 13 – As a full time student you need to be taking 5 subjects (course count of 10)
- If you are selecting a pre-professional course – select this at this stage only (if you wish to do other subjects to create a full subject load – you will do this when you have been accepted into the pre-professional course)
- Your choices are saved as you are going – so you can come back to them

Course Description

13 Classics

Develop your understanding of ancient queenship through a study of several notable queens from antiquity. Explore the reign of Olympias of Macedonia, the Ptolemaic queen Arsinoe II or Hatshepsut of Egypt in terms of how they ruled. Then consider the greatest queen of all, Cleopatra VII of Egypt, and her reputation with later cultures.

Content

- Ancient queenship
- The rule of Olympias, Arsinoe II, Hatshepsut and other queens
- Cleopatra VII as pharaoh: her successful rule, and her later reputation
- Representations of Cleopatra: Roman poetry, Medieval Arabic views, Hollywood and Netflix


