As a responsible dog owner, I agree to comply with the following requirements.
 Dogs must be on a lead when moving around the school grounds. Dogs must be accompanied by the owner, or a designated member of staff. They must not be left alone with students. Dogs must be picked up after and poop disposed of in a sealed bag in an outside bin. Before a dog comes into school the owner must check with students that there are no known allergies and/or discomfort around dogs. My dog is my responsibility in all situations, including in emergencies such as a fire drill, lock down, evacuation etc. I will be responsible for any expenses and cleaning resulting from my dog's actions. I am a responsible dog owner whose dog is well socialised, and to the best of my knowledge is well suited for the purpose outlined above.
