We'll look at how to troubleshoot common stitching issues, along with essential checks and basic maintenance. You'll also get to know different types of needles and presser feet — and how to choose the right ones for your projects.

Throughout the session, you'll create a set of sample seams and hems, then sew a drawstring pouch to store your samples and take home. All sewing is done on manual and electronic domestic Bernina machines.
